

Some animals eat <u>plants and are</u> called herbivores.



Some animals eat other <u>animals and</u> are called <u>carnivores</u>.



Some will eat <u>both</u> plants and animals and are called omnivores..

Who eats what?









A **food chain** is the series of organisms showing feeding relationships.


A food chain almost always begins with a green plant (Producer) which is eaten by an animal (Consumer).

The arrow means 'is eaten by', and shows the **flow of matter and energy** along the food chain.

A <u>food chain</u> shows what animals eat.










FOOD CHAINS

- 2. Snake, Mouse, Hawk, Acorns
- 3. Big fish, Small fish, Dolphin, Algae
- 4. Flower, Seagull, Big fish, Insect, Small fish

A **food web** is a combo of food chains in a given area or ecosystem.
